#### Public Forum:

Lisa Brake at 1801 Washington Street Dyer, AR made the City Council aware that the residence next door to her at 1717 Washington Street Dyer, AR has an unused in ground pool that is a breeding ground for mosquitoes and knats. City Council decided to have Police chief assess situation and issue citation if necessary.

#### Mayors report:

# City of Dyer/Lee Hackler

City of Dyer has received a letter from Philip Bagby who is representing Lee Hackler in a complaint regarding City of Dyer Water Departments accounts at Harmony Road and Washington Street. Hackler alleges the city of Dyer did not complete work ordered in a previous agreement regarding water/sewer hookups. Motion made by Alderman Brown to replace master meter with 4 taps and credit Mr. Hackler \$8000. Mr. Hackler will also be required to connect his 4 dwellings and hook to sewer on Washington Street. Alderman Porter 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion with no opposed.

Letter from Mayor to council recommending the council to only commit city resources that are required by law and make no concession to the threat of a law suit.

#### Black Land Sewer Station:

Motion made to move \$10,000 from reserve for parts to repair the Sewer station by Alderman Brown and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Alderman Fry. No opposition.

#### Fire Department report Jim Dapson:

Fire Department went on 9 calls this month, 5 medical, 1 grass fire, 1 car fire, 1 gas leak and miscellaneous. Dyer Fire department is starting a fund raiser raffle for \$100 certificate to Does Eat Place and a limo ride. Winner will be drawn July 4. Each ticket is \$1 or 6 for \$5.

First weekend in July will be the annual fireworks display at the Dyer Community Building. \$1500 allocated in budget for the fireworks display. Motion made by Alderman Staton to add an additional \$1000 for additional entertainment. Alderman Smith 2<sup>nd</sup> motion. No opposition.
